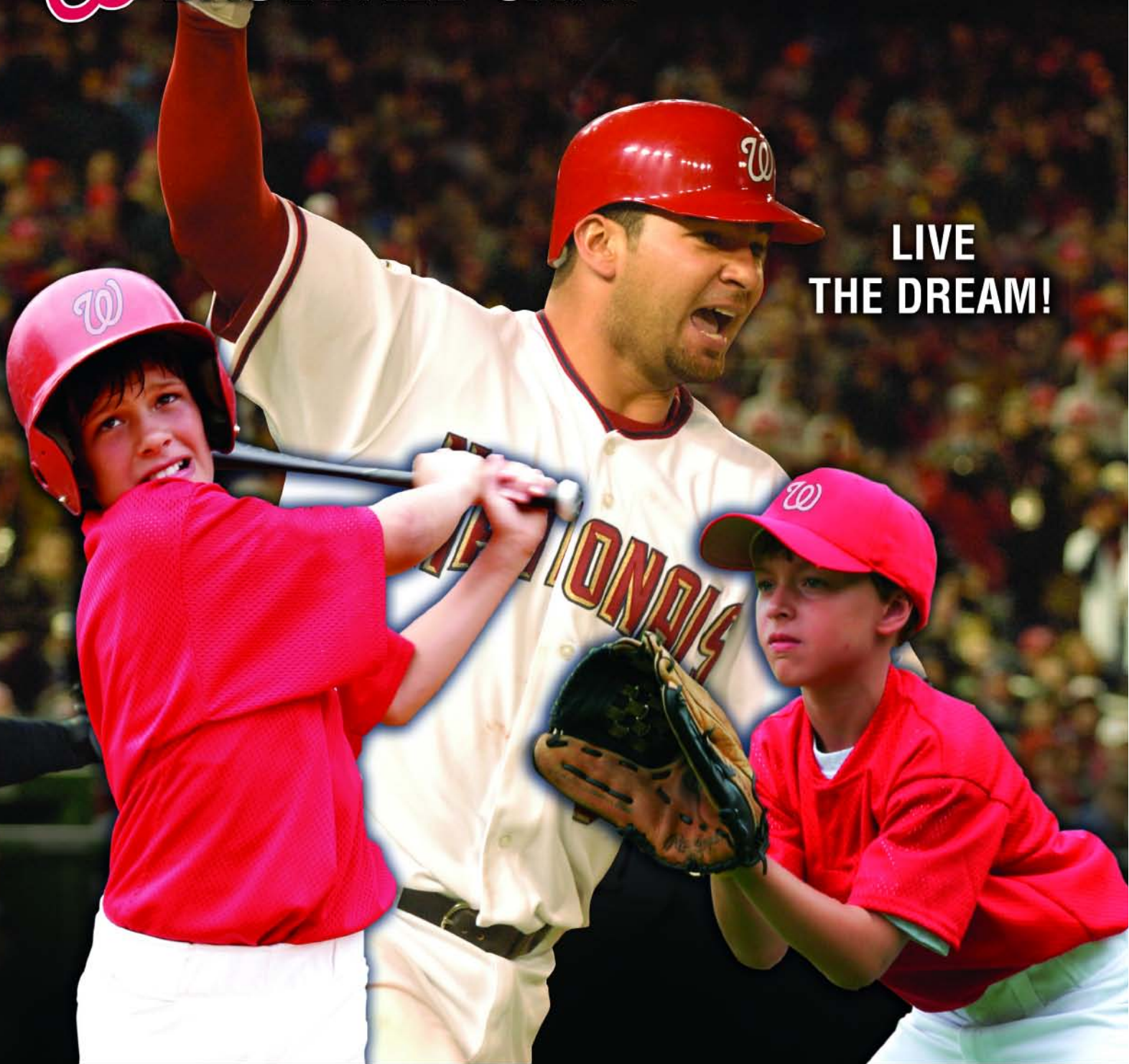

PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW:

On behalf of my child, I accept and assume any and all risks associated with his/her attendance and participation in the camp and its activities (the "Camp"). I understand that my child should not attend the Camp if he/she is not healthy. I understand that my child must abide by Camp policies and the instructions of the camp staff. I agree that should my child be dismissed from Camp no part of my tuition will be refunded. I understand that no reduction in the tuition will be made for late arrival, early departure, vacations, illness or injury. I also understand that in the event of any schedule changes that may be made by Major League Baseball, player appearances and weekly formats could be subject to change. In the event that I can not be contacted in an emergency, I hereby grant ESF, Inc. (ESF) and Washington Nationals Baseball Club, LLC, Washington Nationals Stadium, LLC, Nine Sports Holdings, LLC (collectively, the "Nationals") and each of their respective agents and employees permission to give immediate treatment and/or take my child to a hospital emergency room. I further agree that by signing below, and in consideration of the my opportunity to participate in the camp, I authorize ESF, Major League Baseball Properties, Inc., the Office of the Commissioner of Baseball and all of the Major League Clubs (including the Nationals) and other affiliated entities to depict, in perpetuity, my and my child's likeness, images, words, and voice in photographic, video, audio or other works appearing in any and all media now known or hereafter created for purposes of promoting, advertising, or marketing current or future Camps or other events related to baseball, and I further agree that any and all such Images may be used by them for the foregoing purposes without compensation. Permission is also granted for my child to attend the Nationals Park field trip when offered. Knowing these facts and in consideration for your accepting my child's application for the Camp, I, for myself, my child attending the camp, and anyone else who might claim on my or my child's behalf ("I"), hereby agree that neither ESF, the Nationals, nor Georgetown Preparatory School, are responsible for accidents, injuries, and/or medical or dental expenses arising from my child's participation in the camp and, accordingly, I hereby release, protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless (1) ESF and its affiliated entities, (2) the Nationals and its affiliated entities, and (3) Major League Baseball and its member clubs and other affiliated entities, (4) Georgetown Preparatory School (collectively, the "Indemnitees"), and any employees, agents, officers, directors agents or contractors of the Indemnitees, from and against any and all claims, suits, demands (or other legal actions), losses, damages, costs and/or expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees and disbursements), for personal injury, property damage or any other injury or loss of any kind, whether based in negligence or otherwise (all of the foregoing the "Damages") brought by me in connection with my child's participation in the Camp. HOW TO ENROLL

To enroll, please complete both sides of this enrollment application, sign the form, and return it with a \$175 deposit to the address below. Applications cannot be accepted by fax. Once we have received your application and it has been reviewed, a confirmation-invoice will be mailed to confirm your child's reservation. **The balance of the tuition is due by May 15, 2009.** Full payment of the tuition is required for all applications received after May 15, 2009.

FAMILY, GROUP AND FRIEND DISCOUNTS

A 5% Family Discount is given to all families enrolling two or more children. This discount applies to each child after the first in your immediate family. The first child, enrolled at the full tuition rate, is the camper with the higher early bird tuition.

A 5% Group Discount is available for each member of a group of friends who send their applications together. In order to receive this discount, all applications must be sent together in the same envelope.

Refer Friends to Washington Nationals Baseball Camps and save on camp tuition! Our Group Discount also allows you and any friends you refer to receive a 5% discount off camp tuition. All you need to do is tell friends about camp and send your applications to us in the same envelope! Please Note: Only one discount applies per camper (i.e. Family, Group, or Refer a Friend).

CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES

If you need to cancel your child's enrollment in camp, you must notify us in writing by May 15, 2009 in order to receive a refund. Cancellations on or prior to this date are subject to a \$50 processing fee per child. No refunds will be given out after May 15, 2009 regardless of your registration date.

GROUPING REQUESTS

Campers are grouped according to age and grade level. If you would like your child grouped with a specific friend, please write his/her name and home phone number on this re-enrollment application. Campers **MUST** be entering the same grade next fall. All grouping requests must be made by May 15, 2009.
